Provide Routine Care of the Trail

- ✓ Litter pick-up
- ✓ Clearing drainage areas
- ✓ Keeping trail surface free of natural debris
- ✓ Replenishing trail maps and literature at parking areas
- ✓ Inspecting gates, fencing, information boards, etc.

Report Maintenance Needs

- ✓ Downed trees or overhanging limbs
- ✓ Damaged or missing signs
- ✓ Poor trail surface
- ✓ Invasive plants
- ✓ Repairs to picnic tables and benches

Assist with Special Projects

- ✓ Grooming of trail surface
- ✓ Plantings or landscaping
- ✓ Construction of picnic tables and benches
