Chef's Committee Members Receive Food Certification

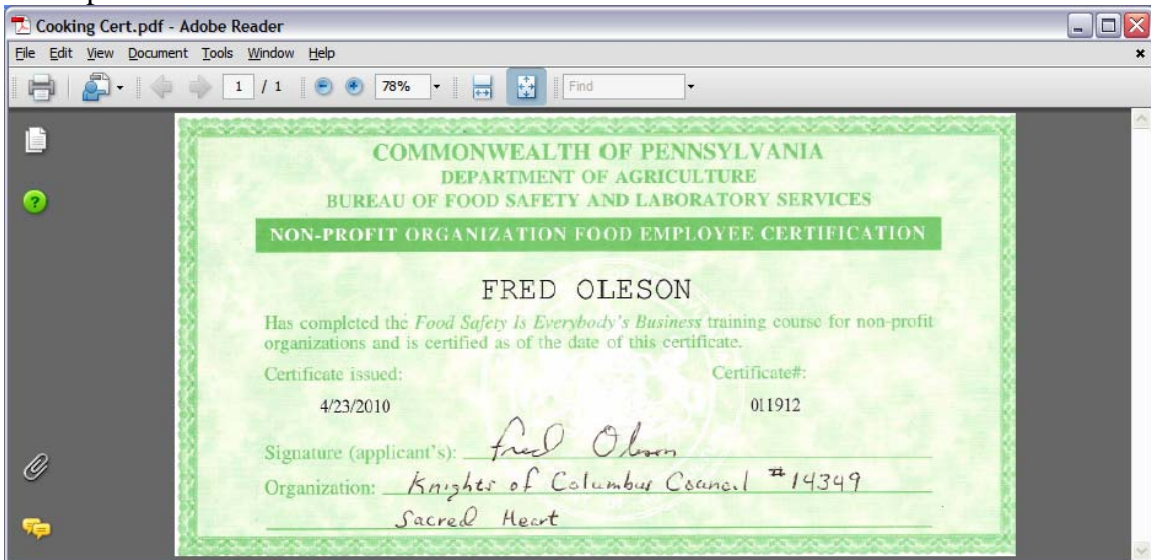
