The date for the clean up will be Saturday 10/23/10.

After the safety briefing the teams will drive to their designated section of the highway and pick up litter along the side of the road. In the past the required time to complete this work has varied from 2 hours to 3 hours.

This activity is open to all council members, and members of their families.
