Dear Church Family,

During the beginning of our Holy Week observances there will be a procession commemorating Jesus's triumphant entry into Jerusalem upon the approach of the Passover feast. This experience will help to enlighten our senses to the Easter Passion.

You are welcome to a light breakfast in St. Paul fellowship hall. You may enter the hall by any of the 3 doors in the rear of the church. At **9:00 the Religious Education students** are to please find Kris Trettel and Marianne Harbold near the corner of the parking lot behind St. Paul Church and Church Street. We will have **the banners the students made**, clothing to be robed in for the garb of the era and palm branches. At **9:15 everyone will gather** at the front of St. Paul Church. There will be a reading as the donkey appears and the story begins. We will process East on Main St. to Mount Zion Church where we will have a prayer and song. We will end in the Sacred Heart Church parking lot with a bible reading and prayer. If you prefer you may stand along the procession route to observe the procession.

Saint Paul Lutheran Church is the beautiful brownstone church on the South side of Main Street at the bottom of the hill across from Glatfelter Paper Co. You may either park at Sacred Heart Church and walk down for the beginning or park at St. Paul and walk back down at the end. Mount Zion Church is ½ way between St. Paul and Sacred Heart Churches. It takes about 20 minutes from beginning to end. The road will be closed to traffic during our procession.

This is a beautiful experience in preparation of Easter. We have been doing this together for many years. There have been many blessings bestowed on those who take the opportunity to be a part of it. The procession will take place rain or shine. Hope to see you there!
